PE ACTION PLAN 2023 - 2024



Summary of current situation in PE

- Currently, we use Wigan Athletic Community Trust (WACT) for the coverage of High Quality PE- excluding swimming provided by Wigan Baths.
- CPD sessions are to continue in 2023-2024 to support staff in the teaching, assessing and building their confident in the delivery of PE. Team Teach approach to be followed and weekly assessment meetings with Wigan Athletic staff. TA's to also be involved in the training.
- Currently, the school hold the Gold School Games Mark award. The school plan to maintain this this year.
- Sporting event participation was lower than usual last year and will be a focal point for 2023-2024.

Subject timeline (jnclude CPD, resources purchased and subject events)

- Monitoring to take place x1 per half term-See Monitoring Plan for specific focus for each half term
- After School Clubs (ASC) to take place from Autumn 1 and continue throughout the year
- Resources Audit to be completed in Autumn 2023 to ensure all equipment is still of high-quality and to ensure staff have everything they need to be
 able to deliver high-quality PE lessons
- WACT to continue to provide high-quality PE sessions x2 afternoons per week
- Wigan Athletic Primary Stars to continue to provide CPD sessions x1 afternoon per week for staff- Focus on assessing and team teaching
- Intra School Sports Competitions to be organised for the spring and summer terms.
- Whole School National Sports week to be planned according to date set (usually June)
- Sports Day booked for July 4th 2024
- RC to attend the Wigan PE lead meeting on 2nd November.
