Summary of current situation in PE

- Currently, the school hold the Gold School Games Mark award. The school plan to maintain this this year.
- Sporting event participation was lower than usual last year and will be a focal point for 2024-2025.
- As of September 2024, school staff will be teaching their own PE lessons following on from previous years CPD training. We will be implementing the scheme Real PE and are due to have further training on this on Wednesday 11th September.
- School have recently just taken place in the Wigan Town Sports event, making it to the final where we came 3rd in the boys 80m and 4th in the boys rely.
