

Autumn Term 2024- Preschool

Dear Parents/Carers,

Welcome back, we hope you have had a lovely summer break and are looking forward to a productive Autumn Term. We would like to take this opportunity to inform you of a few important points for this term:

Our Topic this term is: All about me

Curriculum:

RE- Creation and covenant and Prophecy and Promise

RSHE- The wonder of being special and unique

Personal, Social and Emotional Development – Settling in, and forming positive bonds with others. Learning to follow rules and routines. Play with increasing confidence independently and with others.

Communication and Language – Children will enjoy listening to a range of stories and start to retell them with puppets and props.

Literacy – We will be using our core stories and rhymes to develop a love of reading, and to eengage in extended conversation about stories, learning new vocabulary. We will be using our reading lending library throughout the year so children can enjoy reading at home. We will be encouraging the children to notice their name in printed form throughout the setting.

Mathematics- Colours! Learning about different primary colours. Noticing colours in our world. Matching & Sorting. Make comparisons and comparing amounts due to size, colour and weight. Number 1 & Number 2. Introducing numbers, noticing numbers 1 and 2 in the environment. Linking numerals and amounts up to 2. Patterns. Notice patterns and arrange objects into patterns.

Understanding the World – Make connections between the features of the family and other families. Begin to make of their own life story. Seasonal Change – Autumn. Looking at how our environment and the world around us changes over autumn. Remembrance Sunday – Poppy day. Christmas.

Expressive Arts and Design - Self Portraits – this is me. Express ideas and feelings through making marks, and give meaning to the marks they make. Leaf man characters. We will also look at the Artist Jackson Pollock and create our own Big Art project and explore pumpkin art through the work of Yayoi Kusama. Christmas Performance.

- Please make sure your child brings their book bag to school every day, we will also put any pictures and letters in here, so please ensure you check it daily.
