

Early Years Core Stories and Rhymes

Within Preschool and Reception, we promote and value reading books and singing rhymes and songs as a way of developing children's communication and literacy skills. We read our core books, and sing our core rhymes, regularly with the children, so that they have a secure knowledge of a wide range of stories and rhymes. These have been chosen to reflect all areas of learning within the EYFS, such as numbers and counting, understanding different cultures and positional language.

Within communication and literacy, the chosen books and rhymes develop skills in rhythm and rhyme, alliteration, the development of vocabulary such as nouns, verbs and adjectives and the use of repeated refrains in story book language. These skills support children to increase their speaking, listening and understanding skills.
