Key Vocabulary	
Spelling	Definition
Allies	The United Kingdom, France, the USSR (Soviet Union) and the United States of America led the allied forces
Axis	The Axis Powers were originally Germany, Japan and Italy. Other countries joined them later.
Nazi party	A German political party with racist and anti-Jewish ideas, led by Adolf Hitler.
Atomic bomb	A very high-energy bomb made of radioactive material.
Annex	To take another country's land and make it part of your country
Propaganda	Information designed to promote a political idea or opinion.
Evacuation	When people were moved to rural areas to escape the German air raids.
Air raid -	An attack in which bombs are dropped from aircraft on to a ground target.
Blackout -	When towns or cities are made dark so that they cannot be seen by enemy planes.
Concentration Camp -	Where Hitler sent Jewish people to be killed.
Gas Chamber -	A room into which gas would be pumped.
War -	A state of armed conflict between different countries or different groups within a country.
Holocaust	The mass killing of Jews by the Nazis.
Hitler	The leader of the German Nazi Party
Churchill	Became the UK Prime Minister during WW2.
